> Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mother of the Eucharist, Pray for us.



People of Zion, behold the Lord; he will come to save the world. You will hear his glorious voice as he makes your hearts rejoice.


HYMN: People, Look East (BENÇASON)










AGNUS DEI from "Mass of Charity and Love" (S. Warner)




COMMUNION ANTIPHON: *lerusalem, surge (VENEZ, DIVIN MESSIE)*Baruch 5:5; 4:36



Verses from Psalm 147:
